A 22-year-old parous woman complains of a 3-month history of weight loss, Nervousness, palpitations, and sweating. She denies a history of thyroid disease, and is not taking any weight loss medications. She denies abdominal pain, nausea or vomiting, fever, or prior irradiation. On examination, her BP is 110/60, HR is 110 bpm, and she is afebrile. Her thyroid gland is normal to palpation. She does not have proptosis or lid lag. Her abdomen is non tender and with normal bowel sounds. She is noted to have a fine tremor. Her uterus is normal in size. A mobile, non tender, 9-cm mass is palpated on the right side of the pelvis, which on sonography has the appearance of an adnexal mass with solid and cystic components.
