- The physiology of hearing and equilibrium, nasal and paransal sinuses infections, laryngeal physiology, swallowing and genetics.

- The principles and the international guidelines of managemet of various diseases of the ear and nose and throat as well as skull base and facial plastic.
- The infection control in hospitals and within the community
- The principles governing ethical decision making in clinical practice.

- Assist in stapecdectomy and ossicular reconstruction and head&neck surgical procedures.
