# Cardiac Examination

**1. Perinatal history:**

Maternal DM, cyanosis, respiratory distress

**2. Symptoms of lung congestion:**

Poor interrupted feeding, dyspnea, tachypnea, sweating on feeding in infants, orthopnea, recurrent chest infection, cough and hemoptesis.

**3. Symptoms of systemic congestion:**

Edema, right hypochondrial pain, oliguria and dyspepsia.

**4. Symptoms of low cardiac output:**

Fato, pallor and cold extremities

Percuss (by *heavy percussion*)

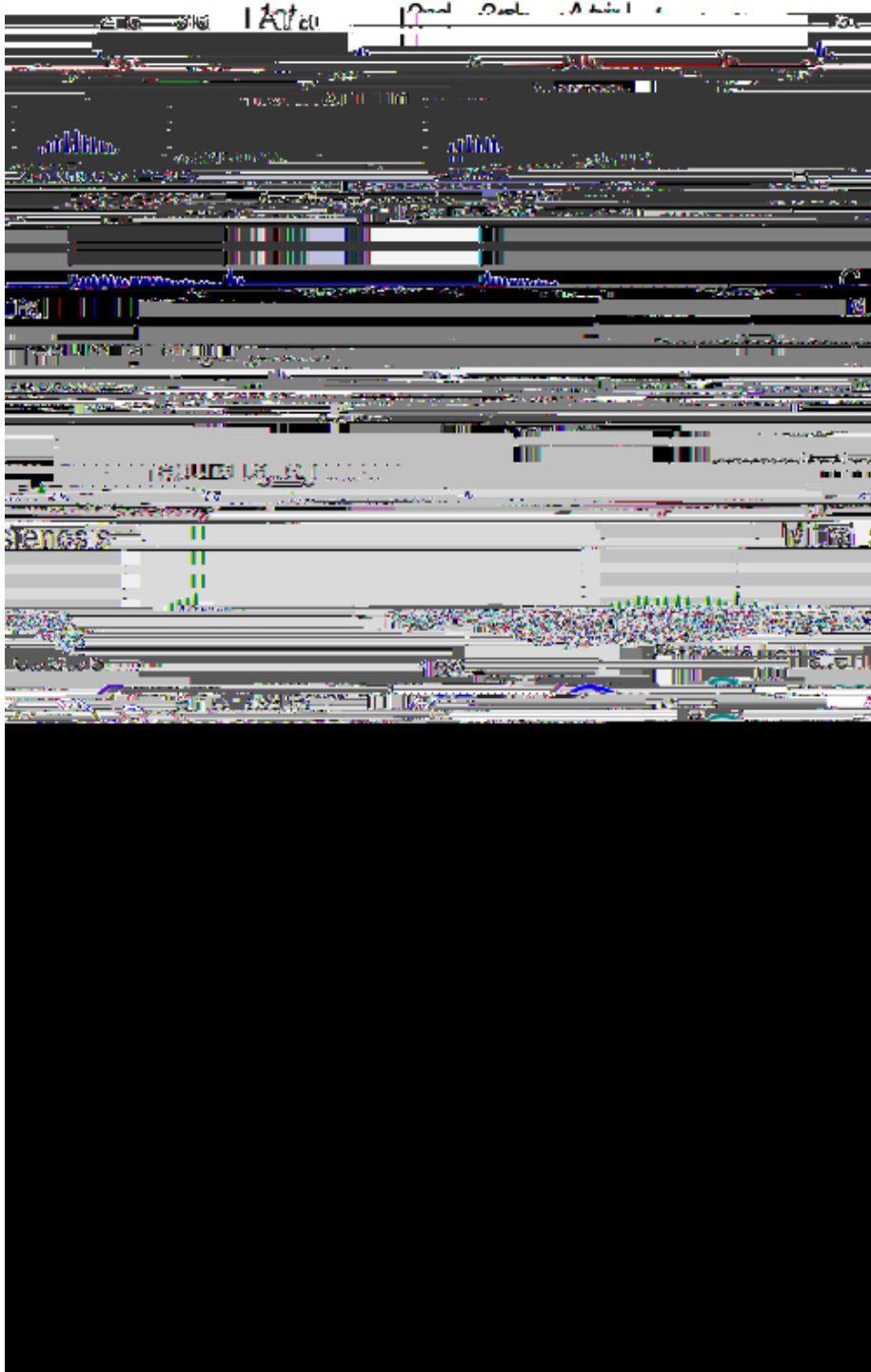
