The response will be contraction of biceps with or without flexion of elbow.

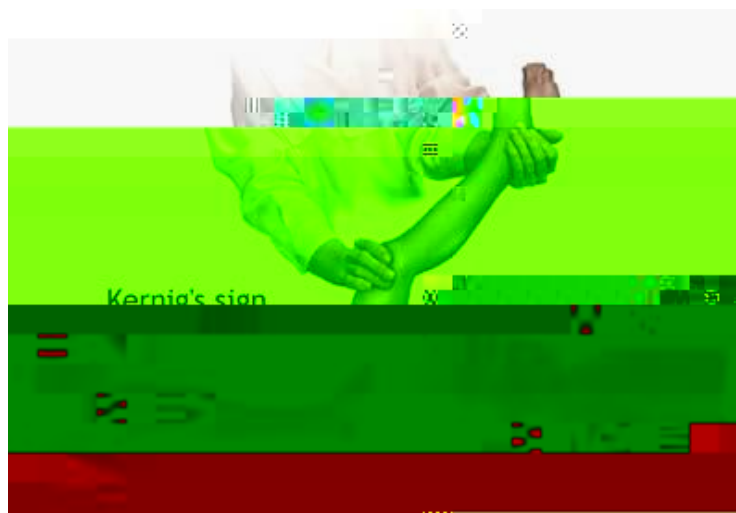
**The Triceps reflex: (C6 C8):**

Patient's arm flexed at 90 degrees at elbow.

- b. Two points discrimination:** It is tested by using two pins or the two limbs of a blunt compass needle. Two points can usually be distinguished from one when they are 0.3-0.5 cm apart on the fingertip, 1 cm on the finger, 2 cm on the forearm, and 5 cm on the leg.



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
